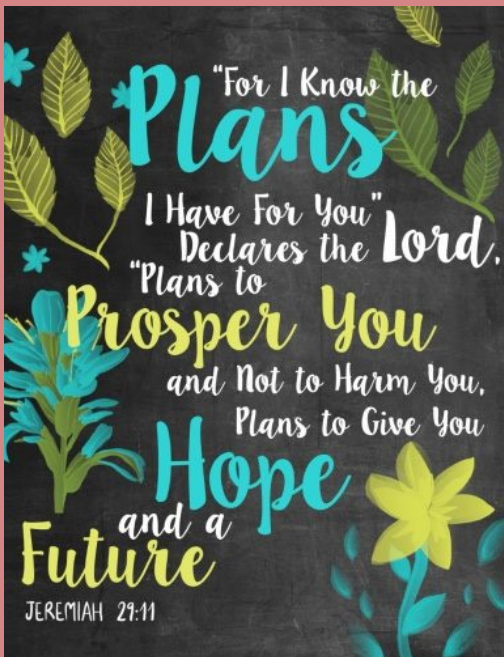

- **Psalms 68:19-20 (NIV):** "Praise be to the Lord, to God our Saviour, who daily bears our burdens. Our God is a God who saves; from the Sovereign Lord comes escape from death."
- **Micah 7:18-19 (NIV):** "Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. You will again have compassion on us; you will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea."
- **Psalms 50:6 (NIV):** "And the heavens proclaim his righteousness, for he is a God of justice."
- **James 1:17 (NIV):** "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly

lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."

- **Psalms 18:30 (NLT):** "God's way is perfect. All the Lord's promises prove true. He is a shield for all who look to him for protection."
- **Numbers 23:19 (NLT):** "God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?"
- **Psalms 84:11-12 (NIV):** "For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord bestows favour and honour; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless. Lord Almighty, blessed is the one who trusts in you."
- **1 John 4:7-9 (NLT):** "Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love. God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him."
- **Exodus 34:5-7 (NLT):** "Then the Lord came down in a cloud and stood there with him; and he called out his own name, Yahweh. The Lord passed in front of Moses, calling out: "Yahweh! The Lord! The God of compassion and mercy! I am slow to anger and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness. I lavish unfailing love to a thousand generations. I forgive iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But I do not excuse the guilty. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children and grandchildren; the entire family is affected— even children in the third and fourth generations."

God's Word is filled with promises from our God to provide and deliver. The Bible is the best place to turn to when you are searching for the truth, as well as what God promises for you. As you read these Bible verses about the promises of God, claim them over your life!

Freedom from addictions, deliverance from sin, financial provision, overcoming depression and anxiety, repairing a marriage, restoring health, being free from fear, hope for lost, and many more are the blessings and gifts that God promises to provide for those who believe in Him.

Gods promises to His Children

- **Isaiah 41:10 (NLT):** “Don’t be afraid, for I am with you. Don’t be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.”
- **Isaiah 26:3 (NIV):** “You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast because they trust in you.”
- **Deuteronomy 31:8 (NIV):** “The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.”
- **John 16:33 (NIV):** “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”
- **Psalm 32:8 (NIV):** “I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you.”
- **Matthew 11:28-30 (NIV):** “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and
 - I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”
- **2 Corinthians 12:9-10 (NIV):** “But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for
 - you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weakness, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ’s sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.”
- **Isaiah 40:31(NIV):** “But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.”
- **Isaiah 43:2 (NIV):** When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.

Psalm 16:5-11 (NIV): Lord, you alone are my portion and my cup; you make my lot secure. The boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; surely I have a delightful inheritance. I will

praise the Lord, who counsels me; even at night my heart instructs me. I keep my eyes always on the Lord. With him at my right hand, I will not be shaken. Philippians 4:6-9 (NLT): “Don’t worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all he has done. ¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸ And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

- **I confess** that I can do all things through him who gives me strength. (Philippians 4:13) I possess supernatural abilities.

Just in case you are doubting yourself today:

1. You were wonderfully made.
2. You are loved.
3. You matter.
4. You are enough.

Today choose: Worship over worry. Faith over fear. Peace over panic. Believe in a sovereign God who gives us all His saving grace.

“No, my daughter, you are worth it. You are worth my love, my grace, my comfort. You are more than worthy of all I pour out over your life.

You are my beloved daughter and princess who I am so in love with and so proud of. You have walked many tough roads, but you have held onto me and trusted me to bring you through it all.

Getting Baptised

Baptism in water is one of the first steps of obedience for a person who has committed their life to Jesus.

- **Matthew 28:19 (NIV):** “Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”
- **Acts 2:38 (NIV):** “...Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”
- **Acts 10:48 (NIV):** “So he ordered that they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ...”

What Baptism means

Baptism is a deeply personal decision; however, it is not a private matter. The Word instructs us to make our choice public. It is an outward expression to all that God has already started in your heart.

- The baptism waters are like a bath. In **Acts 22:16**, Paul says to “be baptized and wash your sins away”. It depicts spiritual cleansing from the guilt of sin.
- The baptism waters are like a graveyard. **Romans 6:4** says that “we died and were buried with Christ by baptism”. Baptism reflects an inward decision to die to “the old you” who rejected and ignored Jesus. Baptism is a break from your sinful past.
- The baptism waters are like a maternity ward. Baptism reflects how we are united with Jesus in his resurrection. We have a new life. **2 Corinthians 5:17** says that “This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!”

Once you have received Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, have repented of your sins, and put your trust in Jesus, then it is time to be baptised. If you belong to a church, or small group then you should speak to a leader about being baptised. Invite your family and friends to witness your decision to follow Jesus with all your heart. It is a wonderful opportunity to share with them what Jesus has done and is doing in your life.
